EMERGENT INDICATIONS:

- Arterial or venous gas emboli
- Decompression illness
- Acute arterial insufficiencies such as:
 - Central retinal arterial occlusion
- Gas gangrene, clostridial soft tissue infections, other myonecroses and necrotizing skin and soft tissue infections
- Crush injuries, compartment syndromes and other acute traumatic ischemia's
- Intracranial abscess
- Severe anemias
- Flaps and grafts that are failing
- Thermal burns (if not going to a Burn Center)
- Idiopathic sudden sensorineural hearing losses (HBO2 mostly effective if offered early)
- CO and CN poisoning
 - Non pregnant patient >25% COHb level
 - Pregnant patient >15% COHb level

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

- Active seizures
- Unstable vitals
- Claustrophobia
- Ear trauma/problems
- Pneumothorax
- Intubation

MISCELLANEOUS:

- There is no weight limit.
- HBO takes approximately 2 hours
